




North End Trail

This scenic trail winds along the North Shore of Lake Berryessa. The trail is a moderate hike with views of Blue Ridge and the full length of the lake. White Pelicans, Bald Eagles and the more common Western Grebes and Osprey live along the shoreline.

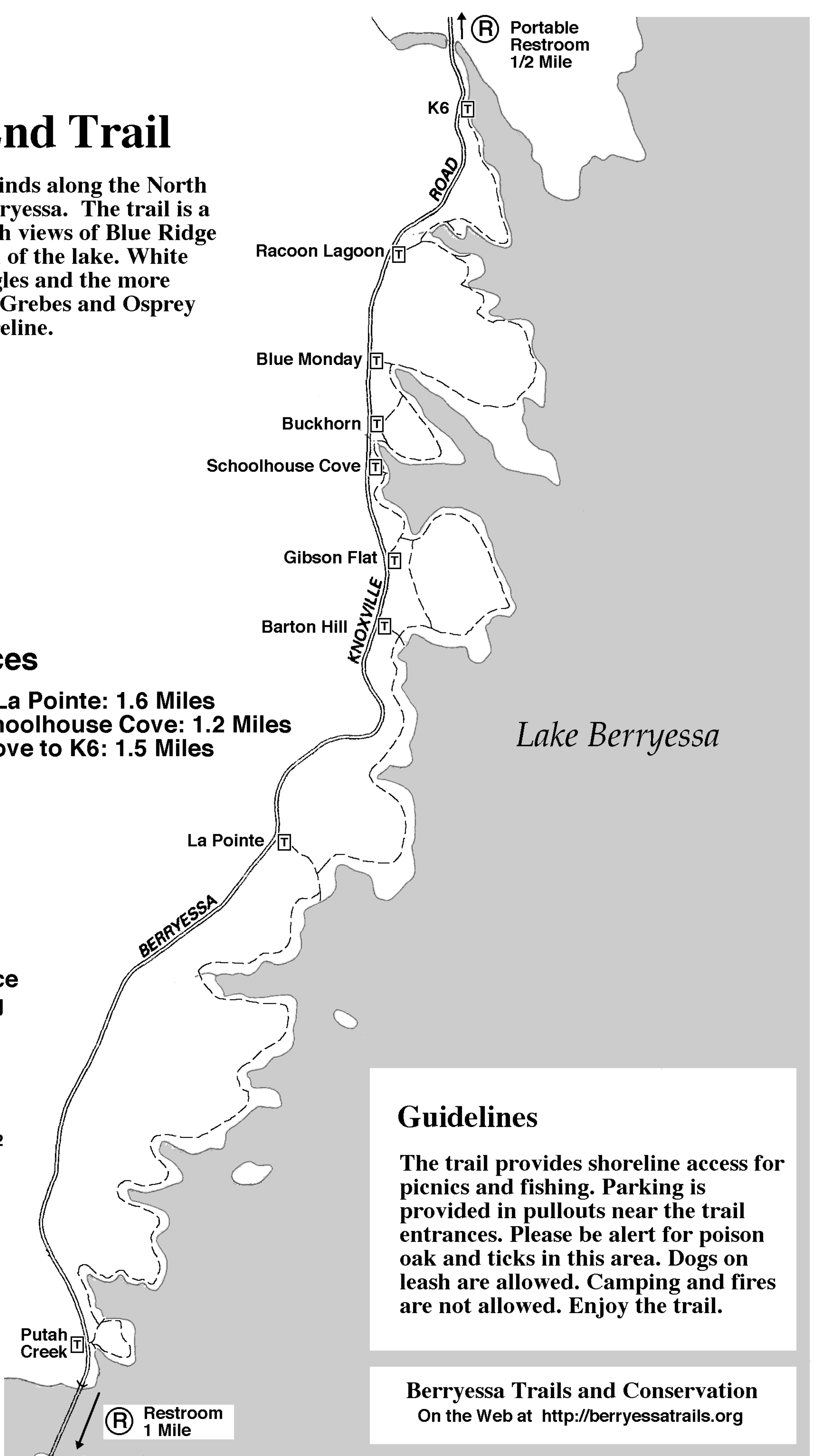
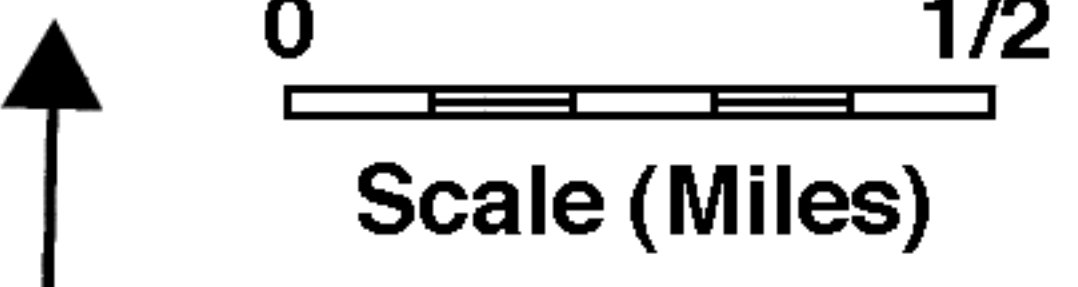
Trail Distances

Putah Creek to La Pointe: 1.6 Miles
La Pointe to Schoolhouse Cove: 1.2 Miles
Schoolhouse Cove to K6: 1.5 Miles
